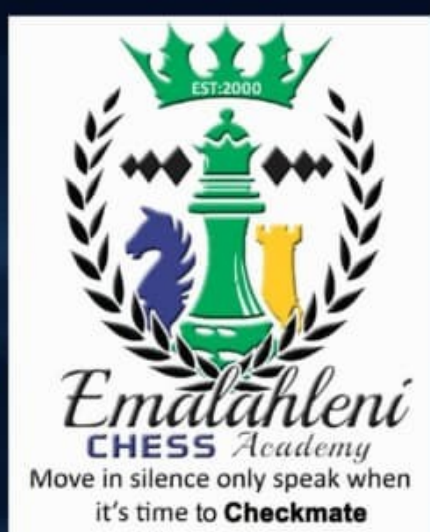

Tournament Regulations

1. CONSENT

- 1.1 The player/parent/guardian gives consent for the player's name, surname, gender, date of birth, Chess SA ID and or FIDE ID to be submitted to the rating agencies (Chess SA and/or FIDE) for the purposes of rating the tournament and the rating agencies displaying it on their respective websites.
- 1.2 The player/parent/guardian gives consent for the publication of the player's details name, surname, gender, date of birth, Chess SA ID and/ or FIDE ID on the website chess-results.com for the purpose of tournament pairings and administration.
- 1.3 The above processing of information is required for the running of this event. Should consent for either of the above be refused, the player will not be able to participate in this event.
- 1.4 The player/parent/guardian gives consent for photo's and/or videos to be taken of the players during the tournament and to be published on social media pages and/or the internet. Should consent not be given, please notify the organisers before the tournament so that the event photographers can be notified.

2. REGISTRATION & PAYMENT

- 2.1 Right of admission is reserved
- 2.2 Players must register using the official registration link:

- 2.4 The deadline for all registrations is **Saturday, 12 September** at 23h59.
- 2.4.1 Late entries will incur an additional penalty of R50 for all sections.
- 2.4.2 Late entries will be allowed until **Wednesday, 16 September** at 23h59. No further entries will be allowed beyond this deadline.

3. SECTIONS & CRITERIA

- 3.1 The Chief Arbiter or Tournament Director reserves the right to move players to a different section based on their discretion.
- 3.2 Eligibility for a section will be determined using a player's Chess SA (Main) rating or their FIDE (Standard) rating.
- 3.2.1 Players must use the higher of the two ratings to determine their eligibility for a specific section

4. PRIZES

- 4.1 Prize money will be awarded strictly based on the final standings determined by the tie-break system. There will be no splitting of prize funds among participants.
- 4.2 Players cannot win more than one prize. Players will receive the prize with the greatest monetary value.
- 4.3 Prize money will be transferred immediately on the day.

5. TIE-BREAKS

- 5.1 In the event of a tie for any position, the final rankings will be determined by applying the following tiebreak criteria, in the order listed below:
- 5.1.1 Direct Encounter
 - 5.1.2 Buchholz
 - 5.1.3 Buchholz Cut-1
 - 5.1.4 Sonneborn-Berger
 - 5.1.5 Number of Victories

6. DEFAULT TIME

- 6.1 There will be a default time of 30 minutes for all rounds. Players who are defaulted will be removed from the subsequent pairings unless they communicate with the Chief Arbiter.

7. DRAW AGREEMENTS

- 7.1 No draw agreements are permitted before move 30. If violated, the result of the game will be 0-0.

8. FAIR PLAY

- 8.1 The tournament is conducted in accordance with the FIDE Laws of Chess.
- 8.2 Fair Play regulations will be strictly enforced throughout the event.
- 8.3 All players must arrive at least 1 hour before the scheduled start of their round to allow for Fair Play checks.
- 8.4 Players may be subjected to random Fair Play checks at any time during the event.
- 8.5 Dress code: Smart casual. Hoodies are not permitted.
- 8.6 Rowdy/intoxicated players may be expelled.
- 8.7 Alcohol/drugs are strictly prohibited.
- 8.8 Smoking is only allowed in designated areas.

9. APPEALS

- 9.1 Appeals must be submitted in writing within 30 minutes of the end of the game concerned.
- 9.2 An appeals fee of R300 is applicable to all appeals. The fee will be refunded for successful appeals.
- 9.3 The Appeals Committee's decision is final and binding.

10. WITHDRAWALS & REFUNDS

- 10.1 Players wishing to withdraw must inform the Chief Arbiter before the first round's pairings are published. If a player withdraws during the event, rating penalties will be applied as per Chess SA Rating Regulations if no valid and acceptable reason(s) are provided by the player.
- 10.2 Players withdrawing from the event will forfeit their entry fee (no refunds).

11. COMMUNICATION

11.1 It is highly advisable that all players (and parents of junior players) join the WhatsApp group to receive updates and communication regarding the event. Pairings will be published to Chess-Results as well as the WhatsApp group on the day of the tournament
